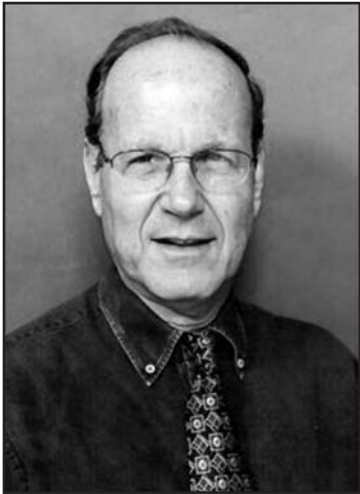

AMBASSADOR YORAM ETTINGER

Ambassador Yoram Ettinger has been working as a private consultant on U.S. policy to Israel's Cabinet Ministers and to the Knesset Committee on Foreign Affairs and Defense since July 2001. At the same time, he is President of EXOP, a business and political consultancy on U.S.-Israel relations, and is editor of "Straight from the Jerusalem Cloakroom/Boardroom" newsletters on national security and US investment in Israel, disseminated to 3,000 selected recipients in the Washington, DC area, including the U.S. Congress.

From 1989-1992 Ambassador Ettinger served as Minister for Congressional Affairs at Israel's Embassy in Washington, DC. That was preceded by his work as Director of the Government Press Office in Jerusalem, and his 1985-1988 service as Israel's Consul General to the southwestern states. He was also editor and founder of the newsletter, "Contemporary Mideast Backgrounder" from 1976-1985, which dealt with Mideast politics and international terrorism.
